### Agenda Title

Discussion and Possible Action to Send a Letter to Supervisor Burgis Urging a NO Vote for Proceeding with the Application Process for a General Plan Amendment to Allow for 170 Residential Units at the N/W Corner of Discovery Bay Blvd. and Sand Point Road.

### Recommended Action

Authorize the President of the Board to sign the attached letter to Supervisor Burgis urging a NO vote for proceeding with an application process for a General Plan Amendment to allow for 170 residential units at the N/W corner of Discovery Bay Blvd. and Sand Point Road in Discovery Bay.

### Executive Summary

It has come to staff's attention that a General Plan Amendment for 170 residential units at the northwest corner of Discovery Bay Boulevard and Sand Point Road, Discovery Bay, will be coming before the Board of Supervisors ("BOS") at their April 12, 2022 BOS meeting for a yes or no vote to proceed with the application process. This comes before the BOS for a vote to allow the application process, not for a vote to approve or disapprove a submitted application.

The adverse impacts of 170 residential units at this location in Discovery Bay are significant and numerous. These include impacts on emergency services response, traffic congestion, infrastructure wear and tear, and hazards to public safety ingress and egress during emergencies. A capacity study would also have to be done to determine if there is adequate water and wastewater availability to service the residential units.

Although the BOS yes or no vote to proceed with the application process is more or less ministerial in nature, the Town may consider voicing clear objection to the location of this project at every step of every process in the chain of County approval.

Attached is a draft letter to Supervisor Diane Burgis requesting a NO vote for proceeding with the application process.
