



INVESTING IN THE FUTURE OF THE TOWN OF DISCOVERY BAY

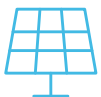
The Town of Discovery Bay provides numerous services, including municipal water treatment and distribution, wastewater collection and treatment, landscaping and parks and recreation services. Over the coming years, the Town will begin several projects to continue providing high-quality services for residents, including but not limited to:



Water Pipeline Replacement: Aging water pipes will be replaced to ensure safe and reliable water service.



Administrative Building: A new administrative building will be built to separate access to the Willow Lake treatment plant, provide a convenient location for residents and comply with state regulations.



Solar Panels: Installation of solar panels will help the Town with efficiency upgrades at the Community Center and Willow Lake Water Treatment Plant.



Well 8 Water Supply Capacity: Well 8 construction will meet the increased water demand and provide reliable service for the growth in the community.



Newport & Sandpoint Underwater Pipeline: The underwater crossing in Newport Bay will be replaced to improve water flow capacity.



State-Mandated Cross-Connection Water Project: Backflow prevention devices required by the State will need to be installed at approximately 4,000 homes to protect the public water supply from contamination.



Wastewater System Renewal: Address aging wastewater facilities to ensure reliable service for the Town's sewer system.

Updating Rates



Like many other public agencies, the Town faces several challenges: aging infrastructure, new and increasingly restrictive regulatory measures, drought, and more.

To continue providing vital services, the Town plans to adjust rates to generate sufficient revenue to fund critical operations, maintenance, repairs, debt payments, infrastructure costs and capital improvement projects, ensuring compliance with regulatory mandates and the long-term sustainability of the Town's investments.
