- Grant Funding application was submitted to DWR in December 2022.
 - o Elements for sustainability were included, such as a generator for the pool.
- LSCE helped create a Regional Groundwater Modeling Update which would allow Discovery Bay to expand the current groundwater hydrology model.
- Spoke with EPA about getting Well Projects funded.
